AHS Working Session: SUPPORTING COLLABORATIVE LEADERSHIP AT THE STATE AND REGIONAL LEVELS

The goal of this day-long working session is to lay the foundation for increased coordination, collaboration, consolidation/integration of state and regional collaborative leadership groups by:

- Clarifying the symbiotic relationship between IFS and Medicaid Pathway
- Honing our conflict resiliency and collaborative leadership skills
- Identifying state level and region-specific strategies to pursue following the working session

This day will offer state partners and teams from seven* AHS regions a professional development opportunity designed to promote increased conflict resiliency among all stakeholders, and an opportunity for state and regional partners to identify strategies to achieve efficiencies among their teams and groups.

Specifically, the day is intended for state-level and regional leaders in these efforts:

- *Children's Integrated Services Administrative Teams (CIS)*
- *Local Interagency Teams (LITs)*
- *Building Bright Futures (BBF)*
- *Other leaders working with interdisciplinary groups funded or supported by AHS or any of its Depts. Identified by their region as (e.g., Accountable Communities for Health, Housing Continua)*

All seven AHS Field Directors, and all members of the IFS State Leadership and the IFS Implementation Teams are strongly encouraged to attend.

* *Cohort 1* regions are Addison and Franklin/Grand Isle. *Cohort 2* regions include Washington, Brattleboro, Bennington, St. Johnsbury and Springfield.

Cohort 3 regions will be invited to attend a working session on March 29th, and those regions are: Chittenden, Lamoille, Newport, Rutland, and Hartford.
