9:30-9:45	<b>Introductions and Board Business:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Approve October Meeting Minutes</li><li>• Update from DVHA on unwinding of Medicaid: <i>Of the enrollees who lost Medicaid at some point during the unwinding period, less than 2% (~6200) were under 20 years old. The reasons for these disenrollments followed the same breakdown as the general population with about half being administrative in nature (nonresponse to renewal), 33% for other reasons like moving out of Vermont, and 15% for confirmed lack of eligibility.
