## Best Practice Guidelines for DCF involvement in ACT 264 meetings

- Teams are REQUIRED to ask the family if they want DCF at the CSP as part of the partnership
- If no DCF involvement:
  - O Parent/Guardian can say NO and no further action needed
    - ➤ No invitation or notification to DCF
  - O Parent/Guardian can say **YES** and facilitator gets releases signed to invite DCF and fill out referral questions
- If there is DCF involvement and no DCF custody:
  - O Parent/Guardian says NO
    - ➤ Discuss barriers and concerns with family and emphasize importance of team discussion and collaboration
    - ▼ It is not considered an ACT 264 if part of the team is not in attendance
    - ➤ Team can have a different type of meeting as appropriate
  - O Parent/Guardian says YES
    - ➤ Fill out releases and invite assigned worker
- If there is DCF custody:
  - O DCF must be present at the meeting
