Two phases: address issues of adding an inflationary clause to the rate setting process and phase 2 will include stakeholder input about how to address other issues with rate setting methodology.</li> <li>Had a dip of children waiting in EDs over the holidays.</li> <li>There are covid outbreaks at CVPH and the Brattleboro Retreat which may slow down admissions.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>DMH focus this session which was testified on today in House Health Care: Suicide Prevention, Peer supports, and mobile response.</li> <li>Allowance for public meetings to occur virtually ends Sunday so an extension from the legislature is being put forward to look to extend to July 2024.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Eating Disorder Legislative workgroup-final meeting was in Dec. group is submitting a report with recommendations. As of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year—the prior auth. For eating disorder residential level of care the authorization has been lifted for those with Medicaid. Hoping private insurance will follow suit.</li> </ul>
